Funeral services for Billy Gene Dodson will be held Saturday, December 26, 2009 at 1:00 PM at the Pentecostal Holiness Church in Cromwell, Oklahoma. Interment will follow at the Little Cemetery in Seminole County.

Billy Gene Dodson was born June 20, 1931 in Henryetta, Oklahoma to Johnny R. and Al Goma (Stephens) Dodson. He passed away Wednesday, December 23, 2009 at his home in Cromwell at the age of 78.
